

Southwestern Conference Ticket Policy

Per the Order of Governor Dewine and the Ohio Department of Health, spectator seating for a facility of 10,000 allows for a maximum of 1,500. Smaller venues may only use 15% of the fixed stadium seating. None of the Southwestern Conference schools have the seating capacity of 10,000 or greater for their venues.

In keeping with this Order, the Southwestern Conference will allow the purchase of two tickets per student participant for both "Home and Away" games. For football, student participant is defined as athlete, cheerleader, and/or band member.

Spectator Ticketing:

- Home event: (2) tickets per student-participant
- Away event: (2) tickets per student-participant

Additionally, the home school of an event has the ability to add additional spectator ticketing should space allow under the 15% rule for capacity. This will only be applied after the home school has accommodated the visiting team's student-participant ticket demand.

The Southwestern Conference reserves the right to review its spectator capacity/ticketing standard on a regular basis. Updates will be made accordingly.

Ticket Prices:

Varsity Football - \$7

Varsity & JV Soccer & Volleyball - \$6

Middle School/Freshmen: Football, Soccer, Volleyball - \$3

Due to the limitations of spectators, the Southwestern Conference has suspended conference passes and use of staff IDs for the 2020 season. The conference looks forward to being able to reinstate passes and IDs when limits are lifted.

Please note: after each contest, student participants and their ticket holders will be expected to leave the facility prior to a new contest beginning so that disinfecting and social distancing can take place.

Band Members and Fans

- All band members will be asked to park in the west lot adjacent to Maple Avenue.
- The band must wear face masks and distance 6 feet apart when not performing.
- The band members will enter the Northeast gate 5 minutes prior to halftime and organize in the North section of the stadium.

- The band parents that wish to watch the band performance only will be permitted to enter the stadium following the band maintaining 6 feet distance between each family.
- An administrator will organize the lines of band parents on the track using lanes 1,3, and 5. Each lane will accommodate 45 total people. If there's more than 135 family members we will use both the East and West side of the track.
- The band will execute their performance and exit through the Northeast ramp and go directly to their cars.
- The band parents will follow the band out of the Northwest gate and go directly to their cars.
- If a band parent wishes to watch the game they can purchase a ticket from the athletic office prior to the event. Each band member is permitted to purchase two tickets.

Spectators:

- Spectators shall self-check for temperature and symptoms. Spectators must stay home if they feel sick, have any COVID-19 symptoms, have had contact with anyone with COVID-19 symptoms or who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past two weeks or if they themselves are supposed to be in quarantine.
- All spectators will be asked to find a marked area in the designated Home/Away stands. Each area marked by a tape represents where no more than two people may sit.
- There will be no outside food or drinks permitted in the stadium.
- All spectators will be asked to designate an area to sit and remain in that seat throughout the contest with the exception of using the restroom.
- There will be no standing room only in the stadium. This includes the mezzanine, the fence around the track and the ramp entrance areas.
- All spectators and facility staff are required to wear face coverings throughout the contest.
- All spectators and facility staff must maintain social distance at all times throughout Finnie Stadium.
- All spectators are not permitted to congregate before, during and after the contest, No tailgating.
- All spectators must follow all signage throughout Finnie stadium including traffic patterns for entering/exiting the stadium and moving throughout the facility.
- All spectators must leave immediately following the contest and should proceed directly to their vehicles following the signage throughout the stadium.

Concessions

- There will be NO concessions at Finnie Stadium.
- There will be NO food or drink permitted in the stadium.

Visiting team bus parking

- After dropping off the teams on the Southwest ramp the busses will park facing south on Maple Avenue. See Map

Home team fan parking

- The primary area for the home team will be the 120 parking spots behind the new Berea-Midpark High School. See Map.

Visiting team fan parking

- The primary area for away team fans will be at the Baldwin-Wallace University Recreation Center and the parking lot west of Finnie Stadium. See Map.

Band member and band parent parking

- The fenced lot on the corner of Maple Avenue and Bagley Road will be designated for band members and band parents only. See Map.
